General Installation Practices

Dear Customer,

- **1.** Before starting work, familiarize yourself with the installation procedure by reading all of the instructions.
- **2.** Throughout this manual, the left side of the vehicle refers to the driver's side, and the right side to the passenger's side.
- **3.** Disconnect the negative (ground) cable from the battery (or batteries, if there are two) before beginning work.
- **4.** Route and tie wires and hoses a minimum of 6" away from exhaust heat, moving parts and sharp edges. Clearance of 8" or more is recommended where possible.
- **5.** When raising the vehicle, support it on properly weight-rated safety stands, ramps or a commercial hoist. Follow the manufacturer's safety precautions. Take care to balance the vehicle to prevent it from slipping or falling. When using ramps, be sure the front wheels are centered squarely on the topsides. When raising the front of the vehicle, put the transmission in park (automatic) or reverse (manual). set the parking brake, and block the rear wheels. When raising the back of the vehicle, be sure the vehicle is on level ground and the front wheels are blocked securely.

Caution! Do not use floor jacks to support the vehicle while working under it. Do not raise the vehicle onto concrete blocks, masonry or any other item not intended specifically for this use.

6. During installation, keep the work area clean. Do not allow anything to be dropped into intake, exhaust, or lubrication system components while performing the installation, as foreign objects will cause immediate engine damage upon start-up.

- 3/8" Drive ratchet with sockets
- 8mm or 5/16" nut driver
- · Jack and jack stands

Highly Recommended:

- Foot-pound torque wrench
- Inch-pound torque wrench








Section 2 Remove Air Cleaner Box

1. Disconnect the negative battery cables from both batteries, *as shown in* **Figure 2**.



- **2.** Disconnect all sensor connectors located on the air box cover.
- **3.** Remove the bolt and washer securing factory air housing .
- **4.** Loosen the hose clamp that secures the air intake tube to the turbocharger inlet. Disconnect the intake tube from the turbocharger
- **5.** Remove the air box and intake tube from turbocharger as an assembly. The air box is held in place with re-usable push-in fasteners and can be pulled out vertically.



Section 4Driver Side Boost Tube Installation, 41345

- **1.** Support vehicle. Remove driver side wheel and fender liner.
- **2.** Use a 7/16" or 11mm socket to loosen the clamps holding the driver's side boost tube to the throttle body and intercooler and pull the stock boost tube through the opening in the wheelwell.
- **3.** Install the supplied silicone hose couplings onto the driver side Banks boost tube. Leave the clamps slightly loose to allow for rotation. using supplied T-Bolt clamps
- **4.** Install the driver side boost tube through the wheel well. Align clamps to allow ease of tightening. Torque Banks T-bolt clamps to 5ft-lbs (60in-lbs).
- **5.** Reinstall fender liner and wheel.

Section 5

Passenger Side Boost Tube Installation, 41346

1. Use a 7/16" or 11mm socket to loosen the clamps on the rubber hose couplings holding the passenger side boost tube.

Note: The factory couplings and clamps will no longer be needed.


- **2.** Install the supplied silicone hose couplings onto the passenger side boost tube. Using supplied T-Bolt clamps.
- **3.** Position the tube in place, slipping the correct end over the turbo charger discharge with the swell on the hose coupling (3) facing out away from the

vehicle as shown in **Figure 1**. Slip the opposite end over the intercooler inlet. Leave clamps loose to allow for rotation.

NOTE: The swell on hose coupling (3) must be facing away from the vehicle as shown in **Figure 1**

4. Align clamps to allow access for tightening. Torque Banks T-bolt clamps to 5 ft-lbs (60in-lbs).

Note: Passenger side boost tube kit will fit with the OEM air cleaner box and Banks airbox housing 42181 rev-E or greater. See **Figure 4**



Section 7 Install Air Box

- **1.** Reposition the air box back into place. Firmly push until the housing feet pop back into the rubber grommets.
- 2. Reconnect all sensors.
- **3.** Install and tighten the intake tube attached to the air box.
- **4.**Reinstall the bolt and washer from radiator core support that secures the air box.

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
